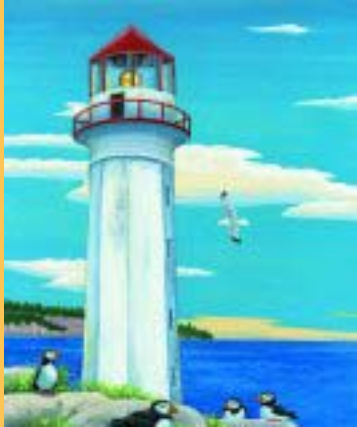

HISTORY OF RIVER VIEW YACHT CLUB

The first home of our club was the a Sacramento River steamer called "Cherokee". It was an old paddle wheeler that was built and launched in August of 1912 from an Oakland shipyard. She carried freight from San Francisco to Sacramento. She was later given to the City of Sacramento after more modern ships were built. It changed hands many times before RVYC acquired her from the Army and Navy Officers Club in 1954.



Earl Moore was the first RVYC Commodore and under his watch the club was accepted as a member of the Pacific Inter-Club Yacht Association.

During the winter of 1966 there were massive storms that washed the pilings away from the clubhouse and the hull was damaged beyond repair. The last cocktail party aboard was held in November 1967 when the old "Cherokee" was toasted and then torched by the fire department. After this, the club lost many members as it had to hold meetings & events in many different locations.

However, the Club had kept a controlling first mortgage and foreclosed with a nest egg for a new clubhouse. The club's bid for the former 62-foot Elkhorn Ferry was successful and in 1971, it was moved to Island Marina where the superstructure was dismantled and the construction of the present day clubhouse began.

The new clubhouse was brought to Bud's Bait Shop in Freeport in 1976 and remained there until 2002 when members decided, after much research, to move it to Cliff's Marina. It took two tugs and the help of several members to accomplish this feat. This is where the clubhouse remains to this date.


