Lift Update...

We have started work on our lift gate installation. The lift has been mounted and tested. Steve Barker, while visiting at the last dinner, and I wrangled a few people to ride it at that time. Everyone

thought it was a cool and important addition.

Boy has the price of steel gone up! The flat piece that you'll be walking on at the top of the lift was \$177.00. By itself! The total cost has yet to be determined but I think we have most of the materials. While I'm at it, I am looking for an anchor. The battery that we (Steve) have found is being TRADED to us for the cost of one anchor. A light fluke style or Danforth anchor has been requested. It's for a 19 ft. runabout. If anyone has a spare anchor that you think may fit the bill, please let me know. Any givers?

Remaining work includes completing the anchoring of the unit to the clubhouse, finishing adding handrails and hardwiring the unit with some kind of a keyed switch to a 12 volt battery. Then, with a little TLC, we will make the lift gate look good as new.


Sounds easy, right?
