TO ALL BOAT OWNERS

Unless Congress passes legislation, every boat in this country will need an EPA discharge permit to legally operate after 9/30/08. Because of a lawsuit targeting ocean-going commercial vessels carrying ballast water and invasive species, the US EPA is required to implement an "operational discharge permit" for all vessels, big and small by this date. To exempt non-commercial boats, Senate Bill 2766 has been introduced. Go to http://www.boatus.com/gov/epa_0408.pdf to see detailed information and what to do.
